Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

As we approach the end of the academic year I would like to bring a number of points to your attention.

The school will be closed on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> of May with classes resuming as normal on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> of May.

The annual Coláiste Cois Siúire Awards night will take place on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> of May at 7pm in the school. Students who are receiving awards will be notified soon.

Leaving Cert Graduation will take place on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> of May at 11am in the school. Sixth Year students and their parents/guardians are invited to attend. There will be no classes for other year groups on this day.

Sixth year students who will have completed the LCVP Link Modules exam on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> of May will have supervised study organised for them each Friday evening until graduation. Sixth years are reminded that aside from this change, their timetabled classes will run as normal until Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> of May. There will be supervised study provided for sixth years following graduation for the week of the 29<sup>th</sup> of May should students wish to access a structured and quiet environment. However, if students are availing of this facility they are asked to do so for the entire school day to minimise disruption on campus.

House exams for all other year groups will take place in the final week of term. Students will finish for summer holidays on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> of June at 1300 (half day).

The Leaving Cert and Junior Cycle State Exams begin on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Timetables are available on [examinations.ie](http://examinations.ie).

Finally, could I ask all parents who wish to make contact with their son/daughter during the school day to please do so via the school office and not via a student's mobile phone. Under the school's Acceptable Usage Policy, students may be asked to use their phones from time to time for educational purposes only. Thank you for your ongoing support in this matter.
